

Position of Visiting Researcher at the Nissan Institute of Japanese Studies for Post-doctoral fellows from the Graduate School of Education and the Institute of Social Sciences at the University of Tokyo

1. Eligibility

Postdoctoral fellows supported by the JSPS or other funds who do research on Japan in social sciences or history and are affiliated with the Graduate School of Education or the Institute of Social Sciences at the University of Tokyo. A good knowledge of the English Language is also required so that you can interact with students/staff members of the Institute and other members of the University as all teaching and seminars are given in English.

2. Objectives

This programme aims to give opportunities to do research at Nissan Institute to young researchers in those two institutions at the University of Tokyo as our visiting researcher for a half or a full year in order to promote academic interactions with our graduate students as well as our academic staff.

3. Status

Like other academic visitors to the Institute researchers will be given a University ID, and if they wish, they can apply for Senior Associate Membership (SAM) at St. Antony's College with the sponsorship of one of our academic staff.

4. Funding

The Nissan Institute cannot provide any financial support. All expenses are to be paid by the visiting researcher.

5. Application

Applications can be made at any time and should be sent to Professor Takehiko Kariya.

- Research Proposal
